August 20, 1932 ~ November 13, 2011

Suzanne was more than a friend to many of us! She was a mentor, a catalyst to volunteer at the Center and a mighty warrior fighting against the injustice of abortion. She built a lasting legacy in our valley in support of mother's and their unborn children. Volunteering for over two decades, she set the bar high for those of us committed to keeping her legacy alive. She was truly a remarkable woman!
